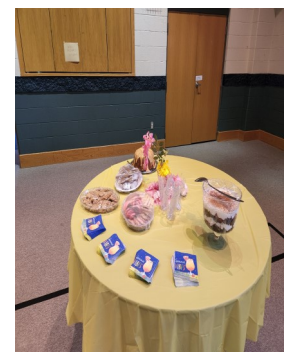
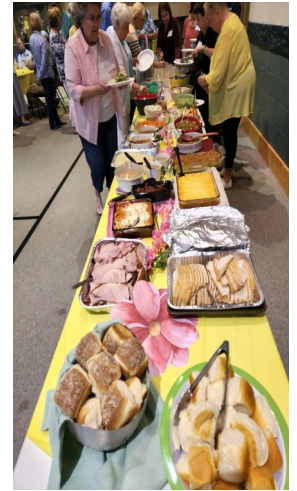


MHPD Explorer's Program
